GENERAL INFORMATION

Every year the members of GIDRM gather for a few days in an Italian city with the aim of exchanging their results in the various fields of magnetic resonance. This year the venue for the annual congress is Bressanone, a small historical town in south Tyrol, about two hours north of Verona. The official languages of the congress are: English for all the main lectures and posters and a choice of English/Italian for the short communications. However, we urge participants to use English also for the short communications so as to make their work comprehensible to our foreign colleagues. Participants will need to find their own accommodation. A number of hotels have agreed to reserve rooms until June 30th. Check the congress web site,

Registration fees include coffee breaks, lunches, welcome reception and social dinner. If **3** people from the *same* institution, with at least one young scientist, register for the conference, only **2** registration fees will be charged!

SCIENTIFIC PROGRAMME

The main topics will be: Methodology, Molecular Reactivity and Design, Functional Proteomics, Interactomics, NMR and Bioinformatics, NMR in Biomedicine, Material Sciences.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR ABSTRACTS

Participants are invited to submit one-page abstracts for contribution as posters. A few abstracts will be selected for short communications.

The template for the abstract can be found in the Congress website.

Page margins must be 2.5 cm wide. Font must be Times Roman 12 or equivalent. Title must be centred in capital letters, beginning just below the upper margin. Then, after a blank line, authors' names must be listed flushed left. Please use first name, middle initials and last name and underline the name of the author presenting the work. Then add authors' addresses. **DO NOT** leave a blank line between authors' names and addresses. Finally, **DO** leave a blank line and write the abstract. If references are needed, cite references using in-line numbers in brackets (like "(4)") throughout the text. The deadline for abstract submission is June 30, 2003. Abstracts must be sent via e-mail, as .doc files, to:
